Qualifications:

A.

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for Universities, and Appendix II (Table 3B) for Colleges, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

Terms and Conditions of Recruitment

(1) Reservation of Posts

- (a) The candidates for the posts reserved for SCs/OBCs categories shall be granted reservation/relaxation/concessions to these categories in recruitment rules pertaining to age, qualifying marks, experience, fees etc., in accordance with the orders/instructions of the University Grants Commission/Government of India on the subject, as prevalent from time to time.
- (b) Candidates belonging to OBC category must produce current financial year Non-creamy layer certificate as per Government of India norms (Annexure-I).
- (c) Candidates seeking reservation under SC/ST category are required to submit certificate on the format prescribed by the Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training (Annexure-II).
- (d) *Payment of TA*: The outstation SC/ST/PwD candidates shall be reimbursed to and fro rail fare (sleeper class) for self only by the shortest route only. In case any station is not connected by rail, ordinary bus fare shall be paid by the shortest route on production of relevant documentary evidence. The above-mentioned concessions shall not be admissible to those SC/ST/PwD candidates who are already in Central/State Government service/or holding any other employment under Government/Government-aided Universities/ Autonomous Bodies/PSUs/ Local Governments/Panchayats.

(2) General Conditions

- 1. Other conditions as per UGC Regulations, 2018, amended from time to time.
- 2. Such appointments will not be made initially for more than one academic session, and the performance of any such entrant teacher will be reviewed for academic performance before reappointing him/her on contract basis for another session.
- 3. A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's level shall be the essential qualification for direct recruitment of teachers and other equivalent cadres at any level.
 - I. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently-abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- 4. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- 5. The candidates belonging to reserved category can apply for the unreserved posts however all the criteria as applicable to unreserved category posts will be applicable to all such candidates.
- 6. Medium of instruction at all levels is generally in Gujarati; hence, knowledge of Gujarati/Hindi is essential.
- 7. Canvassing in any form on behalf of or by any candidate will disqualify him/her from being considered.
- 8. The Gujarat Vidyapith reserves the right not to fill up any of the vacancies advertised and may increase or decrease the actual number of posts in a discipline depending on the circumstances.
- 9. The Gujarat Vidyapith also reserves the right to invite applications, interview/seminar and appoint qualified and deserving candidates.
- 10. If the Gujarat Vidyapith decides to conduct the preliminary test considering the number of posts and application received, the marks obtained by the candidate in the Preliminary Test shall be considered for shortlisting the candidates to be called for interview but such marks shall not be considered for final selection.
- 11. Appendix I (Page 7 of the application from), Eight sets must be submitted.
- 12. Selected candidates are liable to be appointed and transferred to any of the U.G./P.G. campuses of Gujarat Vidyapith located at/or outside Ahmedabad.
- 13. A candidate furnishing incorrect or false information shall stand disqualified.
- 14. Candidates reporting after the reporting time mentioned in the above table for Walk-in Interview will not be considered for the interview.
